Course Description

During 12 weeks' study, Clinical Placement (General Care) and Clinical Placement (Community Health Nursing) will be offer. The descriptions for the four subjects are as following:

1. Clinical Placement (Community Health Nursing) (Code: ICOM4200): Through this practicum, students apply the knowledge of community health nursing to clinical practice. (4 credits, 3 weeks*) (Note: this subject is a 4 weeks' subject for Macau's students, for CCISP exchange students, 3 weeks will be arrange.)

4. **Clinical Placement (General Care)** (Code: IGEN4200): This is the final practicum before the students become qualified nursing professionals. They would have clinical experience resembling a qualified nurse. They are required to practice on shift duties with high levels of independence and professional competence, which are still under guidance of nursing preceptors. (12 credits, 9 weeks*) (Note: this subject is a 12 weeks' subject for Macau's students, for CCISP exchange students, 9 weeks will be arrange.)

Learning Objectives

After completing the course, students will be able to:

1. Apply the knowledge of related nursing theory and skills to care for the client through the practicum.

2. Describe the structure, functions and operations of the institute for clinical placement and its nursing service.

3. Compare the health care system between Macao and Portugal.

4. Understand the culture of Macao Polytechnic Institute and Macao.

5. Improve the friendship between students and two institutions.

Timetable for Internship

During 12 weeks internship, each student has to enroll 2 compulsory clinical placement subjects, which IGEN4200 (General Care, 9 weeks) and ICOM4200 (Community Health, 3 weeks). 12 students will be divided into 2 groups, and maximum number of each group should not be more than 6 students. For IGEN4200, students will practice in Central Hospital Conde São Januário, and for ICOM4200, will practice in one of Health Centre of Macau Health Bureau.

The timetable for each group will be arrange according to the enrolled students.

Notes for Students

1. Please refer to 'General Information for CCISP Exchange Students at MPI (Academic year 2020/2021)'.

2. The students should bring their own nursing student's uniform and shoes.

3. One teacher from MPI and two nursing preceptors will be arrange for every subject during the internship. They will identify the students' clinical learning needs, guide and supervise the students' practice, and assess the students' performance. Students must attain a minimum of 90% attendance and perform clinical assignments before he/she is eligible to be assess for every subject.
