About two dozen works of art are displayed at the Macau Polytechnic Institute (IPM) that aim to showcase new approaches to creative art by the institutes' design and visual teaching staff, according to the exhibition statement.

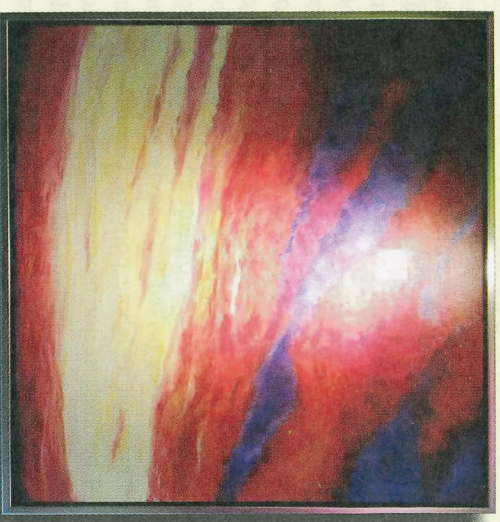
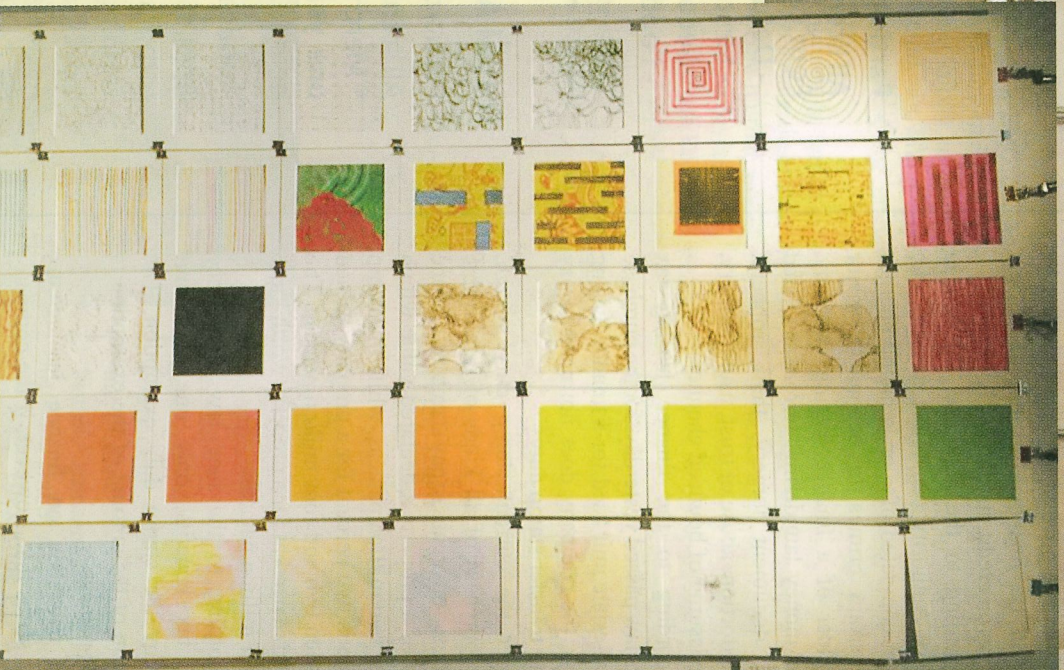
The "Design – Visual Art by Teachers" exhibition is hosted by the IPM School of Arts and takes place on the ground floor of the tertiary education institution's Meng Tak Building.

The exhibition is part of a series of activities of the 4th IPM Art Festival, which aims to raise the level of art production by students and teachers from the institute's design, music and visual arts schools.

Strengthening students' art appreciation can enhance the development of the local creative industries, according to the statement.

The exhibition features a range of artwork using different media materials and various creative forms such as illustration, ceramics, Chinese painting, multimedia and printmaking, as well as installation art.

While the exhibition runs until next Tuesday (admission is free), the IPM Art Festival, which includes concerts and an art fair as well as workshops and seminars, runs until April 27.
