
SAT Calculator Policy: What's NOT Allowed **\(\rightarrow**



1. Calculators with CAS Functionality

Calculator models with built-in Computer Algebra System (CAS) functionality are **NOT ALLOWED**. These models include (but are not limited to):

2. Prohibited Calculator Features & Device Types

Even if your calculator isn't listed above, it's **prohibited** if it has any of these features:

- CAS Functionality: Calculators with apps, menus, or programs that can perform symbolic algebra manipulation (like solving equations, expanding, or factoring algebraic expressions).
- **Keyboards**: QWERTY keyboards.
- **Connectivity**: Wireless internet, Bluetooth, or cellular connectivity.
- Recording Capabilities: Built-in cameras or audio/video recording.
- External Input Devices: Electronic writing pads or pen-input devices (including styluses for calculators).
- Power Requirements: Calculators which require power cords or electrical outlets.
- **Physical Characteristics**: Characters one inch or higher, or a raised display that might be visible to other test takers.
- Paper Output: Calculators that uses paper tape.

General Calculator Rules During the SAT 1

- No Sharing: Students cannot share calculators.
- Reading and Writing Section: Calculators are NOT allowed during the Reading and Writing section; they
 must be put away.
- Calculator Covers: Calculator covers must be kept under the desk at all times.
- Misuse: Using a calculator to share information or remove test questions/answers from the test room will
 result in dismissal and score cancellation.
